Sermon Discussion Questions James 5:19-20 June 3, 2018

1. What do you think of when you hear the word 'wandering'? Where would you love to spend a day wandering around? How is wandering in your faith a completely different experience?

Read James 5:19-20

- 2. Verse 19 tells us that anyone can wander, what are the indicators that you or someone you know is wandering from the faith?
- 3. Share about a time that you may have wandered from the faith, even so slightly. What drew you back?
- 4. How does wandering also put other people and the church at risk? What then is your role in reaching out to those who have wandered?
- 5. The goal with engaging with a wanderer is restoration not condemnation. How then does love "woo" someone back?
- 6. What characteristics, views and attitudes permeate the culture of a church that has a heart for wanderers?
- 7. Is there someone that you know who has wandered, how can God work through you to get this person "back" to the faith?
- 8. We have all wandered off course, is there an area in your life that you are "wandering". How can we help come alongside of you through this time? How do we guard against a wandering heart?

Who helps to hold you accountable in life?
